Bible Questions and Answers

Question: Does the Bible say anything about Dinosaurs?

Answer: Maybe. It is hard to be definite, but what sounds

like a dinosaur (that is, some kind of extinct reptile or other animal) is found in Job 40:15 - - "15Behold now behemoth, which I made with thee; he eateth grass as an ox. 16Lo now, his strength *is* in his loins, and his force *is* in the navel of his belly. 17He moveth his tail like a cedar: the sinews of his stones are wrapped together. 18His bones *are as* strong pieces of brass; his bones *are* like bars of iron. 19He *is* the chief of the ways of God: he that made him can make his sword to approach *unto him*. 20Surely the mountains bring him forth food, where all the beasts of the field play. 21He lieth under the shady trees, in the covert of the reed, and fens. 22The shady trees cover him *with* their shadow; the willows of the brook compass him about. 23Behold, he drinketh up a river, *and* hasteth not: he trusteth that he can draw up Jordan into his mouth" and in Job 41:1, which speaks of "leviathan." These animals don't appear to fit any modern mammalian descriptions, but they do fit the description of a dinosaur. Is that what they were? I don't know. The book of Job is very old, and there is plenty of evidence for saying that man and dinosaur once lived together, but I don't think it's an issue you can learn much about so I wouldn't spend **too** much time on it.
