MORBUS SUNDATICUS

Morbus Sundaticus, or Sunday Sickness, is a disease peculiar to church members. The attacks come suddenly on Sundays: No symptoms are felt Saturday night; the

patient sleeps well and awakens feeling well, eats a hearty breakfast: but about church time the attack comes on and continues until services are over for the morning. Then the patient feels much better and eats a hearty dinner. In the afternoon he feels much better and is able to take a walk, an automobile ride, go visiting, talk politics and read the papers.
