God Exists

- 1) If the human body possesses characteristics of design such that these characteristics could only have come about by the purposeful ordering(designing) of God, then God exists.
- 2) The human body possesses characteristics of design such that these characteristics could have only come about by the ordering(designing) of God.
- 3) Therefore, God exists.

To show that this argument is sound let us look at the human body systems. A single human being is indeed an extremely complex living organism. The human body is composed of various systems that perform certain functions. There is the skin which provides protection, heat regulation, etc. There is also the skeletal system which provides locomotion, blood manufacture by bone marrow, etc. We have a respiratory system which supplies oxygen and

eliminates wastes. The Nervous and sensory system which receives stimuli and transmits and interprets impulses for purposes (cf. Warren-Flew Debate. (Jonesboro, AR: National Christian Press, Inc., 1977) pp. 202-203.). One of the remarkable things about the human body is that all these systems must work in tandem to function properly, they are woven together with the purpose of keeping us alive and working each moment. We could go on much further, but we can clearly see that humans are blest with body systems which exist for the purpose of performing various functions for us, and this exhibits the intelligent design of God; for none other than God could have produced the design we see in the world and in people.

Let's examine a common illustration to help drive the point. Act as if you were "looking from the outside" and pretend you were to see a camera. Now this is a deluxe model with the works. After close examination, would you even begin to doubt that the camera was caused by something, belonged to someone and was a tool used for some purpose? Yet some act as if they can look at the human eye, see that a camera is just a cheap imitation of the eye's complexity and capabilities, and still say that it just happened, no design, no order? Can you believe it? Who can? Just as people use their eyes to make a camera, a thing of obvious design, God used his power to make the human eye.

Our arguments are valid and sound. God must exist by virtue of the nature of the creation which we observe.

Objections

"But, someone may say, it is entirely possible that matter in motion (we will just assume matter and that somehow it is able to do something) through chance produce the universe as we know it out of many, many possibilities." To this we must respond with an emphatic "NO!!" Chance as a cause will not suffice! It is like saying an explosion in a print shop can produce Webster's unabridged dictionary, or that a monkey on a typewriter can produce the Gettysburg Address. That which was not human cannot "by chance" just become human. That which had no intelligence cannot produce intelligence by chance. Chance will not give life. Chaos cannot produce the Cosmos! Every effect must have an adequate cause and the non-intelligent, non-purposeful actions of non-living matter cannot account for the design that has been described.

I close with a quote from an article by Richard N. Ostling from TIME magazine, Fall, 1992. Speaking of science and religion in the future, he says, "The end of atheism and agnosticism became inevitable as soon as computer calculations made improbable the odds that random natural selection could be the sole explanation for the ever increasing intricacies found in biology." This writer would add that it is not just improbable, but simply impossible. **"For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God." (Hebrews 3:4) --Tim McHenry--**
