Report on work in Harlan County

Hello,

I wanted to give you guys an update of the current work here at Mountain View church of Christ.

About a month ago we added 105.1 FM as another broadcaster for our radio program "God's way or Man's way". We were previously just using WCPM AM radio and will be phasing out that broadcast within the next few months because the FM station covers the whole area (and more) that the AM station was covering. We are currently one of the two programs that broadcast on FM.

We also have begun the mailing program called "house to house, heart to heart" in our local area and will be sending out 2000 flyers bi-monthly to the residents of our county. It will take a little over a year for each and every household to have received one of these flyers.

Our church sign should be finished in the very near future and then we can post messages and events publically - this will be seen by approximately 16,000 of the county residents that commute past it each day.

I had recently heard that a local black congregation had given up instrumental music and we have contacted their new preacher who has agreed to sit down with us this Monday and have a discussion. If they turn out to be sound this will give us a congregation of about 20 people located several miles away that we can work within our county.

We've been averaging close to 20 people per Sunday and have several visitors quite often. Chris has been working with a guy who is a co-worker and we are pretty certain him and his wife will become Christians within the next month or so. We've also been working with a couple of families who attend an "anti"

congregation about an hour away. They have visited several times and seem to be looking for a congregation with a strong Sunday school program for their daughters. We're hopeful that they have not been indoctrinated with the "anti" teachings and we're being very tactful and careful in teaching them so that we can show them the truth without offending them.

I hope things have been well at Mt. Gilead and we look forward to inviting you to a gospel meeting we will putting together in the near future after our sign is completed.
