Glendale Hickey 1920 – 2011

When someone displays character beyond the normal, when they become a soul who's life is celebrated by all who know them, when they show special Christian grace – then they are like Glendale "Pop" Hickey. When the September 11 terrorist attacks occurred, Glendale (a WW2 vet) said something like this: "I wish they still let men our age serve, we would go take care of that." He was over 80 at the time!!

A few months ago they found him up on his roof working. I was told when I was in my early 20's and very fit, by Connie's dad who was in his 40's - that Glendale (then about 70) "would outwork us both." I didn't challenge the claim.

No one could ever "push his buttons" to get him mad in any bad way. He was meek and controlled. He was a gentleman and was always ready to go to church.

Glendale's funeral was the longest one I have been in. It took a good 1.5 hours. There were 3 preachers (all in the family) and special memorial statements made by both daughters, two grandchildren, and one great-grandchild. This was followed by a graveside service with full military honors.

Isn't it great to have someone to gather around and listen to at supper time? Someone who can tell you true stories about the old days that really teach you a lesson? My prayer is that all of you get to have a patriarch in your family that others will look up to and talk about when they pass on.
