

DANIEL'S 70 WEEKS, DANIEL 9:20-27

True prophecy is far different from "88 reasons the Lord will return in 1988"

- I. 70 weeks: 70 prophetic weeks of 7 years each. $70 \times 7 = 490$ years, see Lev. 25:8
- II. Read Daniel 9:20-27

Body

I. What would be accomplished in the 490 years:

1. The transgression would be finished
2. An end would be made to sins.
3. Reconciliation for iniquity would be made.
4. Everlasting righteousness would be brought in.
5. The vision and prophecy would be sealed.
6. The Most Holy would be anointed.

II. Beginning of the 70 weeks: Different dates could be used. For example if 457B.C. is used (see Ezra 7:6-7), then we have $490 - 457 = 33$ A.D.

III. Calculating the weeks: It took while to rebuild Jerusalem and the temple in particular (read Ezra and Nehemiah). Perhaps 49 years. Then we have $7 + 60 + 2 = 69$ weeks, after which the Messiah week would arrive (70th week). In this last week Messiah would be "cut off," but accomplish great things for us (verse 27).

IV. Fulfillment:

1. Finish the transgression. – Complete the Jewish punishment for sins?
2. Luke 23:34; Rom. 3:25 and Heb. 10:4
3. Rom. 5:10 and Eph. 2:16
4. Romans 10:1-10 "Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth."
5. All fulfilled – John 19:30
6. Anointing was fulfilled at the latest by Mark 16:19.

V. Abomination of Desolations: When Titus came with the Roman army – see Luke 21:20 and Matthew 24:15-21.

Lessons:

1. God is behind the Bible because the writers were inspired to write about the coming of Jesus hundreds of years before He came. (cont. on page 4)

2. God's will was done through Christ, just as He planned, and all things will be done according to His wishes – be patient.
The church escaped by believing God! We escape damnation the same way

What must I do?

- **Hear the Gospel - Acts 15:7**
- **Believe the Gospel - Mark 16:15,16 (cont. on p.4)**
- **Repent of Sins - Acts 17:30**
- **Confess Christ - Rom. 10:9,10**
- **Be Baptized for the Forgiveness of Sins - Acts 2:38**

Then, as a Christian we must:

- **LIVE FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH - REV. 2:10**
