


## Tidings From Timothy

## Righteousness Exalteth a Nation

**“R**ighteousness exalteth a nation; but sin is a reproach to any people.” Proverbs 14:34. These wise words need to be heeded in a country like ours today. It is a shame when countries not based on Christian principles are more just with their people than we are in the United States. Now don't get me wrong, we live in a great country, but I am speaking of the judicial system in particular. It is a perversion of the truth to say that punishment is not a godly motivation to get people to do what is right.

Now there are two problems about which Christians as citizens should be concerned. The first is that we have all seen how that criminals are coddled in some cases. Why should this be? Since when do love and mercy throw justness out the door? God is all righteous *and* all loving; there is no contradiction. Our God is long-suffering and merciful, but that does not mean that any sin not repented of will go unpunished. Let us consider an irresponsible person who is, say, a drug abuser (and yes, alcohol is a drug). This man will not respond to treatment or counseling. What shall we do with him? Well, why not try tying him up to a tree and whipping him? If he is going to act as a child and will not respond to reason, then maybe he will respond to punishment. What if that doesn't work? What if he's a drunk driver who is a special menace to others? Lock him up for a while. “But,” some may say, “don't you know that prisons are already overcrowded?” I don't care. Pack 'em in like rats. If they are going to behave as an animal then let them live like one, it's their choice. And by the way, while they are in the pokey – *rehabilitate them*. It is a shame that nowadays we just let them sit in the jail and rot. However, I don't know where we got the idea that a criminal has a right to so many square feet of private space or that needs cable TV. Even if you call those “rights,” he lost them when he beat his wife, stole from his neighbor, refused to pay his taxes, or whatever.
