How To Know When I Am Ready to Become a Christian?

Are you thinking about becoming a Christian, but don't know if you're ready? You are not alone in asking this question. Many people come to worship every week and

contemplate this question.

To help you gain some peace of mind and some understanding, here are some questions that you can ask yourself to help you to decide if you are ready to become a Christian.

- * Do you believe that Jesus is the Son of God who died and was raised from the grave on the third day? Do you believe that He is Lord and Savior? Rom. 10:9-10. **Yes or No**
- * Do you believe and know that there is sin in your life that you need to turn away from and quit doing by repenting? Luke 13:3 and 2 Corinthians 7:10. **Yes or No**
Are you willing to confess your belief in Christ before other people? Mt. 10:32. **Yes or No**
Are you willing to be immersed in water (baptized) for the remission of your sins, receive the Holy Spirit, Acts 2:38, Acts 22:16, and Romans 6:3-4. **Yes or No**
- * After you have been baptized are you willing to live faithfully to God by obeying Christ's commands (Mt. 28:20), and by living the lifestyle that He wants you to live, doing good deeds (Eph. 2:10) worshiping regularly with the church (Heb. 10:25) and remaining faithful to God until death (Rev. 2:10)? **Yes or No**
If you have answered "yes" to all these questions then you are ready to become a Christian. We here at Mt. Gilead want to assist you as soon as possible in confessing your faith, repenting of your sins and putting Christ on in baptism. This is all you need to do to become a Christian. You don't have to have the Bible memorized, or have great knowledge about religious matters; just simply confess your faith, repent of your sins, and be baptized.
If your answer is "no" to any of these questions then we want to encourage you to continue to study the Bible and keep asking

questions so you will soon be ready to become a Christian. The elders are available to answer any questions you have. Becoming a Christian is an important decision that may take some people more time to decide than others.

Jesus loves you and wants you to be happily walking with Him. One of our goals at Mt. Gilead is to help you to obey the Gospel of Jesus and become an active part of His Kingdom.
