Brevity · Evidence of Inspiration

The London Times once described J.W. McGarvey as the greatest Bible scholar on either side of the Atlantic. In a discourse on the inspiration of the Bible delivered in the summer of 1893, McGarvey noted mainly internal evidences for the Bible's inspiration. For instance, he noted the brevity of the New Testament narratives. Even in describing dramatic events, the inspired writers generally don't give lengthy details to satisfy our curiosity. McGarvey noted the Lord's baptism as an example of this practice. As you may know, God broke the verbal silence of several centuries by verbally acknowledging Jesus as His beloved Son in whom He was well-pleased. Amazingly, the glorious event is recorded in very few words. Matthew, who gives the lengthiest treatment, only employs a dozen lines, Mark and Luke six, and John a single sentence of approximately twelve words. McGarvey asked, "What man with a writer's instinct could have stopped short of many pages in describing the scene so as to do it justice?" I think that McGarvey makes an interesting observation, don't you? Strictly human authors would have likely gone on and on. Of course, this is but one of many evidences for the inspiration of the Bible (2 Tim.3:16-17).

What must I do?
