(LESSON FOR SUNDAY NIGHT)

Scripture Reading: I John 1:7-9 Song for the Lesson: Blessed Assurance

People often express dissatisfaction their religion. I am not talking about being upset with God, but rather being upset with themselves. Some express their feeling of defeat and lack of confidence in salvation with statements like: "Whatever I do, it's like it's not good enough" or "I feel like I'm in a No-win situation." Others live a fearful life by wondering if they have been "good enough" to make it to Heaven. There are three ways we can treat this condition:

1. Recognize that I am free and cleansed because of **Jesus'** goodness and faith.
2. Develop confidence in your own personal salvation.
3. Be satisfied that you will always search for perfection, but never attain it.

This lesson is about the point that was just made.

- I. I know I am saved because God said so.
- II. I know I am saved because I can judge.
 - A. America is trapped in a belief of moral and religious relativism.
 - B. If I don't know who is lost, how can I know who is saved?
- III. I know I am saved because I pass the tests.

Let each one examine their own soul and **know** where they stand with God
