WHEN WE COME TOGETHER

Jesus gathered with His disciples. He instituted the Lord's Supper, He spoke of betrayal, then a dispute broke out over who would be the greatest, **Luke 22:14-38**. After the resurrection, one assembly went from sorrow to joy, **John 20:19-30**. Jesus assembled with His disciples over breakfast and one soul was restored, **John 21:10-19**.

In Acts, gatherings varied in theme and content:

1. They met from open temple courts to houses. The fellowship was good, **Acts 2:46-47**.
2. When forbidden to preach Christ, the disciples gathered and prayed, **Acts 4:23-24**.
3. The assembly was a place to be accepted, **Acts 9:26-27**.
4. After Cornelius was converted to Christ, Peter and others assembled for a few days, **Acts 10:44-48**.
5. In one assembly in Antioch, a need was presented and responded to, **Acts 11:27-30**.
6. A very important assembly in Jerusalem met false teaching head on, **Acts 15:1-2**.
7. The gathered church in Antioch was glad to receive instruction from the Apostles over a false doctrine that troubled them, **Acts 15:13-15**.
8. One prayer meeting down by the river relocated to Lydia's house after she became a Christian, **Acts 16:13-15**.
9. A jailor, converted to Christ fed Paul and Silas in his house. There was joy, **Acts 16:33-34**.
10. After a riot in Ephesus, Paul gathered the disciples together for encouragement and to say goodbye, **Acts 20:1**.
11. At Troas, the assembled church celebrated the Lord's Supper, ate a meal together, and Paul preached until midnight, **Acts 20:1-11**.
12. Paul was well received by the Jerusalem brethren and reported all that God had done among the Gentiles, **Acts 21:17-26**.
13. Though under house arrest, Paul welcomed all who came to see him and "without hindrance" preached the kingdom of God and taught about the Lord Jesus Christ, **Acts 28:30,31**.

To say we gather to worship is not a complete description of all we do when assembled. Like them, our assemblies are varied, productive, and encouraging. Do you value the assemblies of the

Lord's church? May we always proclaim Christ while we long for His return. One more time, read Hebrews 10:23-25.
