She writes in her autobiography, ***Bubbles:***

“I was now only thirty-four, but a very mature thirty-four. In a strange way my children had brought me an inner peace. The first question I had when I learned of their tragedies was self-pitying, ‘Why me?’ Then gradually it changed to a much more important, ‘Why them?’ Despite their handicaps they were showing enormous strength in continuing to live as normal and constructive lives as possible. How could Peter and I show any less strength?”
