Cream of Chicken soup	Canned Chicken and Dumplin's	

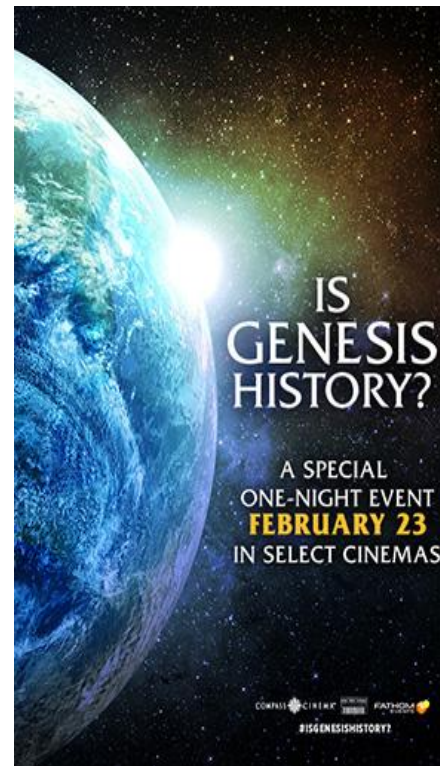
Surely we can collect some of that this week. Just put it in the back fellowship area or in the basket out front
