This week's article is the first of a 4-part series on worshipping with heart by Farrell Nicholson who preaches for the Agnos church of Christ in Agnos, AR.

**WORSHIPPING WITH HEART**

When the Lord Jesus went through Samaria, "being wearied with His journey" (John 4:6), He stopped and rested on the structure of a 75-foot deep well and spoke to a woman from that region about the generations-old dispute between the Samaritans and the Jews over basically, who had been right and where was the proper place to worship God—Jerusalem as the Jews taught, or Samaria as her people taught. The Master settled the matter for His and her contemporary time: "Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship; for salvation is of the Jews" (John 4:22). He immediately followed that declaration with, "But the hour cometh and now is, when the true worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship Him: (v. 23). The Father—His, hers, yours, and mine—seeks the true worshipers to worship Him. And these "true worshipers" are whom? Those who worship the Father in spirit and in truth. "God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth" (v. 24). While the author loves the pattern of worship set forth in the New Testament—and strives to practice it and contend earnestly for it (Jude 3)—the worship of God the Father in truth is not the thrust of the article here. Our purpose here is to proclaim that the true worshipers of God must worship Him with Heart, in spirit as well as in truth. (continued next week).
