They believe with James that "the effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much" (James 5:16). We have reported in our congregation numerous times when our prayers have been answered regarding some individual for whom we had been praying.

Yet, "The Prayer List" is only taking up so much space in a church bulletin if the brothers and sisters do not respond to it. Perhaps its best use is this: when you get your bulletin and
