In the first five verses of Psalms 63, David gives some great advice on how to make worship meaningful:

“O God, You are my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You In a dry and thirsty land Where there is no water” (v.1) – **Worship begins with a deep longing to be with God.**

“So I have looked for You in the sanctuary, To see Your power and Your glory.” (v.2) – **Anticipation for worship heightens as one is searching for the right attitude in which to worship.**

“Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, My lips shall praise You. Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name.” (v.4- 5) – **True worship cannot be contained and will express itself in the praising of God.**

“My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness, And my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips.” (v.5) – **Worship culminates in the filling of the soul.**
